Completed in October 2021 our brand-new purpose-built site in Brownhills has everything your precious little one needs to start their educational journey.

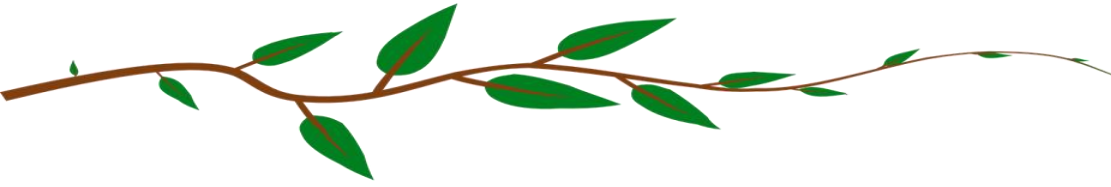

Our Vision

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Opening Hours

The nursery is open all year round, excluding Bank Holidays and occasional shutdown periods at Christmas, from 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday.

Children's Age Groups

All children are cared for in separate groups according to age and corresponding to the Early Years Foundation Stage Framework.

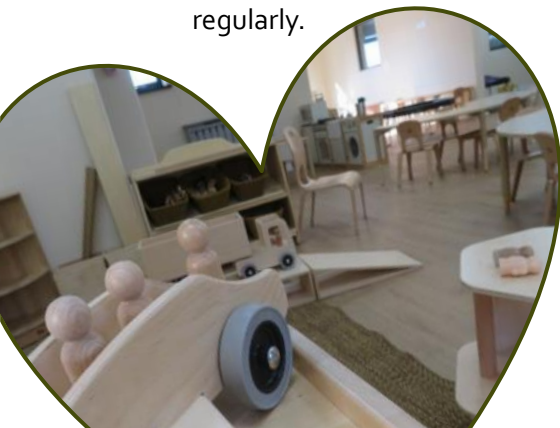
These are generally in three age groups:

- 0 - 2 years
- 2 - 3 years
- 3 - 5 years

Each group has a set amount of space available.

We adhere to staff to child ratios in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage Framework and Ofsted guidelines.

All equipment and resources are appropriate to children's developmental needs and are regularly checked and monitored by the manager risk assessing the nursery regularly.



Starting Nursery

We are a nurturing, home from home nursery and follow your routine here so the child can feel as comfortable and happy as possible.

All children are offered a home visit before joining us. This gives us an insight into your child's existing daily patterns and routines, considering likes and preferences. Although children change very quickly, and routines alter as a child's needs change and develop, it can be useful for parents or carers to have a home visit to discuss details about your child's requirements and your expectations of the nursery environment.

Settling in sessions prior to the actual start date at nursery are encouraged to suit each individual. We offer a 1 hour session to begin with, allowing parents to stay for the session. This is also an opportunity for you to spend time with your child's key person to exchange and document important information to allow a smooth transition into nursery for your child.

The second session we offer then will be 2 hours, however we encourage parents to leave the child.

We offer these two weeks prior to the nursery start date and can offer more if we feel the child needs it.

We work closely with health colleagues and require all parents/those with parental responsibility to bring in their child's Health Record Book (known as the red book) upon enrolment or to the first settling-in session.

Extra Charges

If you would like an addition hour, it would be charged at £10 per hour.

Breakfast, lunch, snacks, and dinner are all included in the price.

Funded sessions will be charged for any food during those sessions.



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Funded Sessions

The Nursery Education Grant (NEG) is a government grant which funds all children aged 3 & 4 years old to have 15 hours free education before they start school.

As many parents/carers may be aware from September 2017 families meeting a specific criteria are able to claim an additional 15 hours, free childcare on top of the existing 15 hours already available to all 3 and 4 year olds.

This additional offer is aimed specifically at those families who meet the criteria below:

- All parents/carers must be working in the household
- All parents/carers must be working the equivalent of 16 hours a week on minimum/living wage
- All parents/carers must be earning the national minimum/living wage
- All parents/carers earnings must be no more than £100,000 per year
- 'Parent' means a person who has parental responsibility for the child, in cases where a parent has remarried or is living with a partner, the step-parent or partner must also meet the learning threshold
- Foster carers are only eligible for the extended entitlement for their own children (if they meet the criteria); and not eligible for children they foster.

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For further information and guidance please see www.gov.uk/30-hours-free-childcare Parents can choose whether to use it as 30 hours per week during term time or 22 hours per week across 51 weeks of the year.

If you don't meet all of the criteria, the good news is that you'll still qualify for the 15 hours free child care that is currently available. Your child could also qualify for "Think 2" which entitles 2 year old's for 15 hours free funding.

Tax-free childcare is a Government-backed scheme which helps parents with the cost of childcare. The scheme, which launched in April 2017, gives eligible families an extra 20% towards childcare costs. For further information please see www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare

Breakfast starts at 8am and finishes at 830 am.

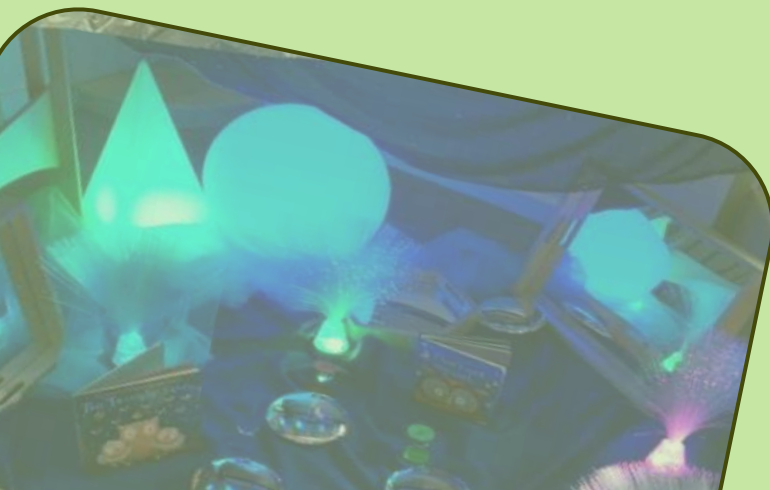
AM snack starts at 10am and ends at 11am.

Lunch starts at 12 for the toddler and preschool rooms.

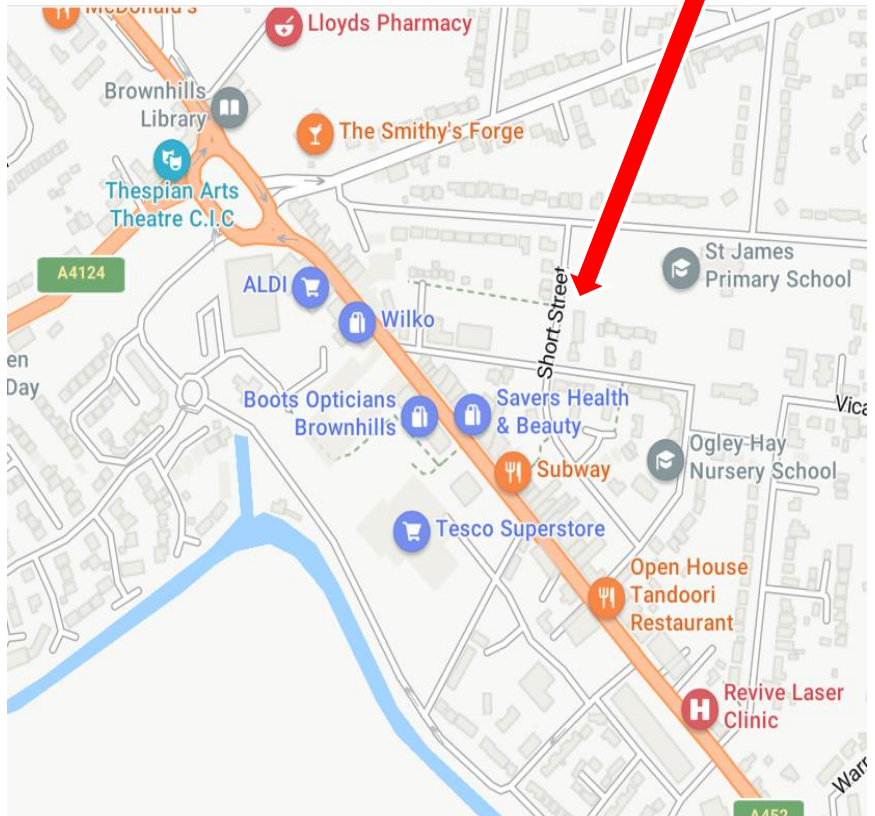
PM snack starts at 2pm and ends at 3pm.
